CHECKLIST

For LDAF Licensee Compliance

This checklist is being provided by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture & Forestry as a guide to assist Industrial Hemp Program licensees comply with the application, licensing and reporting requirements.

Complete State and Federal Background Checks. Background reports are due with license application and are valid for a maximum of 60 days prior to license application submittal.
Submit License Application(s) and all required supporting documentation. May be submitted anytime during the year, but prior to possessing any hemp plants or seeds.
Pay license fee(s) to LDAF. Payable upon notification of license application approval.
Obtain license through LDAF. License will be issued after approval of application and receipt of payment.
Submit Seed Acquisition Form(s) to LDAF. Must be approved by LDAF in writing prior to receiving hemp plants or seeds. May be submitted anytime during the growing season.
Submit Site Modification Request form to LDAF. All sites must be preapproved by LDAF prior to any hemp regulated activity occurring on or within the site. May be submitted anytime during the growing season.
Submit 1st Quarter Planting Report. Due for all greenhouses and indoor growing structures on or before March 31 st of each year.
Submit (post-planting) Planting Report. Due a maximum of 15 days after planting for both outdoor and indoor plantings.
Submit 2nd Quarter Planting Report. Due for all greenhouses and indoor growing structures on or before June 30 th of each year.
Submit Harvest/Destruction Report. Submit prior to anticipated crop harvest or destruction.
Submit 3rd Quarter Planting Report. Due for all greenhouses and indoor growing structures on or before September 30 th of each year.
Submit Annual Production Report. Due on or before November 15 th of each year.
Renew License for next crop year. Due on or before November 30 th of each year.
Submit 4th Quarter Planting Report. Due for all greenhouses and indoor growing structures on or before December 31 st of each year.
Submit Voluntary Driver Reporting Form. Form may be submitted any time during the license year.
